Blue Devils Head Tropical to Play Two Games in Cancun, Mexico...

For the Thanksgiving holiday, the 11th-ranked Duke women's basketball team (3-1) will head tropical as the Blue Devils will participate in the Caribbean Challenge on Nov. 26 and 27 in Cancun, Mexico. Duke will take on Western Kentucky (3-0) on Thursday, Nov. 26 and then will face Marquette (3-1) on Friday, Nov. 27. The contest on Thursday against the Lady Toppers will tip at 6:00 p.m. (EST) and against the Golden Eagles on Friday, the Blue Devils will play at 7:30 p.m. (EST). All games will be played at the Moon Palace Resort.

Duke is ranked No. 10 in the Associated Press and No. 12 in the ESPN/USA Today Division I Coaches Polls.

Noting Duke...

Senior **Bridgette Mitchell** will play in her 100th career game against Western Kentucky ... the Blue Devils hit a season-high five three-pointers, blocked a season-high 12 shots and had a season-low 12 assists against Charlotte on Monday ... with her career-high eight assists against Charlotte, junior **Jasmine Thomas** now owns 201 career dishes ... Duke has registered a 14-1 record during the last 10 years at tropical destinations (Cancun in 2000 and 2006, Bahamas in 1999 and 2004 and St. Thomas in 2002 and 2007) ... the only losses for Duke in the Caribbean were in 1997 with a 77-65 loss to eighth-ranked Illinois in San Juan, Puerto Rico and in the 2007 Paradise Jam to second-ranked Connecticut, 74-48.

A Look At Western Kentucky...

Western Kentucky enters the Caribbean Challenge with a 3-0 record with victories over Eastern Kentucky, Ball State and South Dakota State. The Lady Toppers are led by Amy McNear (18.3 points, 5.6 assists), Courtney Clifton (12.7 points) and Arnika Brown (12.7 points, 13.0 rebounds). Head Coach Mary Taylor Cowles enters her eighth season with Western Kentucky and returns all five starters from last season's 16-13 squad.

The Series With Western Kentucky...

Duke and Western Kentucky will meet for only the third time in school history and the second straight season. The Blue Devils defeated the Lady Toppers, 59-56, at Western Kentucky last season on Nov. 28, 2008.

The only other meeting came on March 20, 2000 in the second round of the NCAA Tournament with the Blue Devils winning, 90-70. The game was played in Durham, N.C.

A Look at Marquette...

Marquette enters the Caribbean Challenge with a 3-1 record and a two-game win streak against Creighton and Oakland. The Golden Eagles will take on Cleveland State at 2:30 p.m., on Nov. 26 prior to taking on the Blue Devils on Nov. 27.

The Golden Eagles have been led with three double-digit scorers on the season -- Jessica Pachko (11.8 points), Lauren Thomas-Johnson (10.8 points) and Angel Robinson (10.5 points). Robinson is coming off notching the first triple-double in school history against Oakland with 10 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists. Marquette is coached by Terri Mitchell, who is in her 14th year and owns a 258-147 record.

The Series With Marquette...

Duke and Marquette will meet for the third time in school history and the first time since March 23, 2004 in the second round of the NCAA Tournament. The No. 1 ranked Blue Devils won 76-67 in Cameron Indoor Stadium. The other meeting came on Nov. 29, 1998 in Cameron Indoor Stadium with Duke notching a 91-60 victory.

Storylines/Other Blue Devil Notes...

- Senior **Bridgette Mitchell** leads Duke with 16 offensive rebounds on the season. Over her four-year career, she has totaled more offensive rebounds than defensive rebounds each season. For her career, she owns 192 offensive boards and 156 defensive rebounds.

- With her four blocks against Charlotte, junior **Krystal Thomas** moved into 10th place on Duke's all-time blocked shots list with 79. She passed Payton Black's 78 career swats and is just two away from ninth all-time.

- Junior **Karima Christmas** hit 2-of-4 from downtown against Charlotte, which broke a streak of seven consecutive missed three-point field goal attempts to open the season.

- After shooting 45.5 percent from three-point land in two exhibition games, Duke has struggled from downtown to open the season hitting only 20.0 percent (14-of-70). Eight Blue Devils have attempted a trey on the year.

- Duke is averaging 17.0 steals a game through four contests so far. The Blue Devils are also playing big on the boards outrebounding opponents, 51.2-31.5 (+19.8).

- Over her 18 years as a head coach, **Joanne P. McCallie** owns a record of 2-3 against Western Kentucky. She is 1-0 versus the Lady Toppers as the coach at Duke and was 1-3 versus WKU while at Maine. McCallie has totaled a 1-0 record against Marquette with the 65-63 win coming while she was at Michigan State on Dec. 2, 2001.

- Against teams from the Sun Belt Conference, Coach P owns an all-time record of 6-4 -- Arkansas State (2-0), Denver (1-0), FIU (0-1), Middle Tennessee State (1-0) and Western Kentucky (2-3).

- Coach P owns an all-time record of 17-9 against Big East teams -- Cincinnati (2-0), Connecticut (1-3), DePaul (1-0), Marquette (1-0), Notre Dame (2-0), Pittsburgh (1-0), Providence (3-3), Rutgers (2-3),

South Florida (3-0) and Villanova (1-0).

- The 95 points allowed by Duke at Texas A&M on Nov. 15 was the most allowed by a Blue Devil team since the 104 points Connecticut scored on Nov. 13, 1998. The 56.9 field goal percentage by the Aggies on Sunday was the highest allowed by Duke since Florida State shot 57.4 percent on Feb. 4, 2004. The game broke Duke's 51-game ACC winning streak.

- In the season opener on Friday, Duke scored 104 points and won by 69 points at Houston Baptist University. The 104 points was the most scored under a team led by **Joanne P. McCallie** at Duke and the 69-point win was the largest margin of victory for a McCallie-led Blue Devil squad. The Blue Devils also hit 55.7 percent from the field, which is the second-best field goal percentage for a Coach P led Duke team. The high was 56.0 percent against Virginia on March 6, 2009 in the ACC Tournament.

Duke Makes Return To Caribbean Challenge...

The Blue Devils previously played in the Caribbean Challenge in 2006 with Duke registering victories over 25th-ranked Bowling Green (55-46) and SMU (75-45).

Jackson Productive in First Start...

After not playing in either of the two exhibition games, senior **Keturah Jackson** came off the bench

to open the season at Houston Baptist and Texas A&M. In the home opener against Georgia Southern, Jackson got the starting nod and took full advantage of it.

In the contest versus the Eagles, Jackson notched 11 points, six rebounds, five assists and two steals in 27 minutes played. The 11 points was one shy of a career high and her five assists was a new career high. The 6-0 guard hit 5-of-7 field goals on the night.

So far on the season, Jackson owns a team-high 15 steals. Jackson is coming off having rotator cuff surgery on June 8 and was finally cleared for full action on Nov. 13 for the season opener at HBU.

Duke Versus the Sun Belt...

Duke has won 8-of-9 games against Sun Belt opponents. The only loss to a Sun Belt team was against Florida International on January 1, 1984 when the Blue Devils fell, 56-83.

Duke Versus the Big East...

The Blue Devils have matched up against Big East teams 47 times, winning 31 of those contests. Duke has won three straight games against Big East opponents and seven out of its last 10.

Balanced Attack...

Through four games this season, Duke has featured a very balanced scoring attack. The Blue Devils own four players averaging double-figure scoring -- **Jasmine Thomas** (13.5), **Bridgette Mitchell** (11.8), **Joy Cheek** (11.5) and **Krystal Thomas** (10.0).

Duke registered all five starters scoring double-digits on Nov. 19 against Georgia Southern and eight of the 11 Blue Devils have notched 10+ points in at least one game this season. Since 2002-03, Duke has notched five starters in double-figure scoring only eight times.

Three different players have led Duke in scoring out of the opening four contests -- Thomas (2), Mitchell and Cheek.

Big on the Boards...

Through four games, Duke has been huge on the boards as the Blue Devils are averaging 51.2 rebounds a game. Duke has registered a total of 205 rebounds in those contests, which is the fifth-highest total in school history.

In 1984-85, Duke had 218 rebounds, 2006-07 the Blue Devils had 214, 210 in 1994-95 and 2009 in 2008-09 through four games.

Vernerey Giving Good Minutes in the Post...

Blue Devil freshman **Allison Vernerey** continues to give Duke key minutes off the bench in the post so far on the year. The 6-5 center is averaging 7.8 points and 6.5 rebounds on the season. Her 9-of-14 free throw attempts rank second on the Duke squad.

She totaled a career-high 11 points and seven rebounds at Texas A&M on Nov. 15.

What Is Next?...

Duke will return home to host two straight games against third-ranked Ohio State and Southern California. The Blue Devils and Buckeyes will play in the ACC/Big 10 Challenge on Thursday, Dec. 3 at 7:00 p.m. Duke

Thomas Fires Away At A&M...

Junior **Jasmine Thomas** registered a career-high 26 points at 16th-ranked Texas A&M on Nov. 15. The Fairfax, Va., product hit a career-high four three-pointers, attempted a career-high and school record 14 three-pointers and attempted a career-high 28 shots.

In the contest, Thomas also pulled down nine rebounds, three assists and three steals in 38 minutes.

Through three games on the year, Thomas is averaging 14.7 points, 6.7 rebounds, 4.3 assists and 3.7 steals. Of the nine three-pointers Duke has hit on the season, Thomas has made five of those.

Breaking Down the Exhibition Games...

In two exhibition games against Wingate and Alaska Anchorage, the Blue Devils averaged 99.5 points and held their opponents to only 31.5 points and a 22.1 field goal percentage.

Five Duke players averaged double-figure scoring -- **Jasmine Thomas** (18.5 points), **Allison Vernerey** (17.0 points), **Karima Christmas** (15.0 points), **Joy Cheek** (13.0 points) and **Kathleen Scheer** (10.5 points).

Duke shot 50.7 percent from the field and 45.5 percent from three-point land as five different Blue Devils hit at least one three-pointer. A total of 19 blocked shots were featured, eight by **Krystal Thomas** and four by Vernerey.

Thomas Selected Naismith Candidate...

Duke junior **Jasmine Thomas** has been named one of 50 preseason candidates for the Naismith National Player of the Year trophy.

The watch list was compiled by the Atlanta Tipoff Club's Board of Selectors, which based its criteria on player performances from the previous year and expectations for the 2009-10 college basketball season. The Naismith Trophy presented by AT&T will be awarded at the 2010 NCAA Women's Final Four in San Antonio, Texas.

Cheek Nets Honor...

Duke senior **Joy Cheek** has been named one of 30 candidates for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence - classroom, character, community and competition.

Cheek, who is a native of Charlotte, N.C., has been a very steady performer for the Blue Devils over her career as she has played in 101 games, while starting 40. She owns career averages of 7.8 points and 4.6 rebounds, but is coming off averaging a career-best 8.5 points and 4.7 rebounds as a junior. Over her four years, Cheek has led Duke to 84 victories, three NCAA Tournament appearances and two ACC Championship game appearances. Duke was a No. 1 seed in the 2009 NCAA Tournament and has finished no lower than third in the ACC each of her three years.

In the classroom, Cheek posted a 3.10 GPA in the fall of 2008 and earned ACC Honor Roll accolades in 2009. Over the summer of 2009, Cheek was selected to perform an internship at the White House in the Vice President's Office in Economic Policy. She was there for 14 weeks and got a chance to look from the inside-out at the operations of the White House and the federal government.

The 6-1 forward has been very involved in the community since arriving at Duke four years ago. She has worked with a group of girls at the Emily K Center, made visits to the Ronald McDonald House, assisted at the Durham Soup Kitchen, helped needy families during Christmas, spoken at the girls club and helped with the Durham Children's Hospital. While an intern at the White House this past summer, Cheek and the other interns held a book drive for the local community.

Duke Tabbed No. 6 In Preseason National Polls...

The Associated Press and *USA Today*/ESPN released its preseason Division I women's basketball polls with Duke being tabbed No. 6 in both listings.

With the Blue Devils ranked in the top 10, it marked the 10th straight year Duke has been tabbed in the top 10 of the preseason Associated Press (AP) rankings. Overall, the Blue Devils have been listed in the top 25 of the AP poll for 188 straight weeks, which is the longest current streak in the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) and third nationally.

McCallie Enters Third Campaign...

After securing her "Dream Job" in April of 2007, **Joanne P. McCallie** guided the Blue Devils to a 25-10 overall record in her first season and then posted a 27-6 mark and a No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament in year two.

In three years so far with the Blue Devils, McCallie has led Duke to a 55-17 overall and a 21-7 league mark. Duke has advanced to the NCAA Tournament both years as well as the ACC Championship.

McCallie's group made history in 2008-09 as the Blue Devils became only the

In her 18 years as a head coach, McCallie has led 13 teams to the NCAA Tournament, registered a 371-165 overall record, was the 2005 National Coach of the Year, won five conference championships and collected 13 20-win seasons.

Other Preseason Rankings...

Duke was tabbed fourth nationally in the *Athlon* Magazine preseason poll, while also being listed sixth by *Lindy's* Magazine and fifth in the *Sporting News* College Basketball Preview issue.

Junior **Jasmine Thomas** was also selected preseason second team All-America by the *Sporting News*.

Experience Returns...

Duke returns two starters and nine letterwinners from last season, while losing three seniors -- **Chante Black**, **Carrem Gay** and **Abby Waner**. Both Waner and Black were selected in the WNBA Draft, and Gay signed with a professional team in Israel.

The Blue Devils return 58.5 percent of their scoring and 63.3 percent of rebounding from a year ago.

Duke returns five players who started at least two games from last year -- **Jasmine Thomas** (28), **Bridgette Mitchell** (11), **Joy Cheek** (16), **Keturah Jackson** (16) and **Karima Christmas** (2).

Other returning letterwinners include **Chelsea Hopkins**, **Kathleen Scheer** and **Shay Selby**.

Blue Devils Add Three Freshmen...

Head Coach **Joanne P. McCallie** added three freshmen for the 2009-10 campaign -- **Allison Vernerey** (Alsace, France), **Janeé Johnson** (Matthews, N.C.) and **Alexis Rogers** (West Chester, Ohio).

Vernerey, a 6-5 center, played for France in the U-19 World Championship over the summer, where she averaged 6.2 points, 6.8 rebounds and 1.2 blocks. She notched 15 rebounds, nine points, two blocks and one steal in 26 minutes versus Lithuania to close out the championship. She is also a member of the French National Team.

Rogers, who attended Lakota West high school, is a 6-1 wing and was ranked as high as 24th in the Blue Star Report after averaging 15.0 points, 7.8 rebounds, 2.3 steals and 1.7 assists as a senior. She was the 2009 GMC, Butler and District 15 Player of the Year. Rogers posted 10 double-doubles as a senior and finished second in career points (1,027) and rebounds (536) at Lakota West in just three years.

Johnson, a 6-1 forward, was tabbed No. 62 in the Blue Star Report in the class rankings. She averaged

12.1 points, 7.0 rebounds, 3.5 steals and 1.6 assists as a senior at Providence Day School. Johnson earned NCISAA All-State first team accolades, while also being named All-Conference, *Charlotte Weekly Super Team* second team, *Charlotte Observer* All-Observer third team and *Charlotte Observer* All-Mecklenburg County second team.

Jackson Returns For Fifth Year...

Fifth-year senior **Keturah Jackson** will return for her final year with the Blue Devils after receiving a degree in sociology over the summer. Jackson is attending the Fuqua Business School in 2009-10 at Duke.

Over her career, Jackson has seen action in 90 games and made 26 starts. Known best for her defensive play, Jackson has notched 109 steals in 90 games, while averaging 3.2 points and 2.7 rebounds.

She will look to continue Duke's trend of having very successful fifth-year seniors over the last number of years -- **Chante Black**, **Lindsey Harding** and **Monique Currie** all stayed five years and were All-America selections in the final year.

Trio of Blue Devils Have Offseason Surgery...

Both **Chelsea Hopkins** and **Shay Selby** had surgery on their right knees in the offseason by Dr. **Alison Toth**.

A native of Las Vegas, Nev., Hopkins appeared in 20 games as a freshman this past season, while averaging 2.7 points, 1.1 rebounds and hitting 51.9 percent of her field goals. She originally hurt her knee in the Western Kentucky contest on Nov. 28 and missed five games. Hopkins came back to play 16 games following the Christmas holiday.

Selby, who is from Cleveland, Ohio, saw action in 26 games in her first year with the Blue Devils. She averaged 2.7 points, while hitting 10-of-24 three-point field goals for a 41.7 percentage.

Fifth-year senior **Keturah Jackson** also had surgery over the summer as she suffered a torn left rotator cuff in a pick-up game at home.

As a junior, Jackson averaged 3.1 points, 2.9 rebounds and 1.3 steals. A product of Columbia, S.C.,

Over the summer, Kevin Lehman was added to the women's basketball staff and Sarah Smoak was promoted. Lehman joins the staff as an Assistant Director of Basketball Operations, and Smoak will now serve as Director of Marketing/Assistant Director of Basketball Operations for women's basketball after having interned for the team in 2008-09.

In her new post, Smoak will develop and execute marketing and promotional concepts with women's basketball along with the day-to-day operations of the program, assist with game and practice preparation, help arrange team community involvement and assist with on-campus recruiting.

A Lancaster, Ohio native, Lehman comes to Duke after two years as the Director of Basketball Operations for the Eastern Michigan University Eagles. Prior to his time at Eastern Michigan, Lehman worked as a student manager and assistant video coordinator for the Michigan State University women's basketball program while earning his undergraduate degree. In 2007, Lehman graduated from Michigan State with a Bachelor of Arts degree in journalism.

Lehman will assist with on-campus recruiting, recruiting correspondence, team travel, special event functions and planning, game day operations, video editing and coordinating the scout team.

Duke Picked No. 2 in the Preseason ACC Poll...

In a vote by the Blue Ribbon Panel, the Duke women's basketball team was selected No. 2 in the preseason Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) poll, which was released on Oct. 26, 2009. The panel is a contingent of national and local media, as well as school representatives

Duke received 10 first place votes, while North Carolina earned 30 first place votes on its way to being picked No. 1. Florida State was third followed by Virginia, Maryland, Boston College, Georgia Tech, Miami, N.C. State, Wake Forest, Clemson and Virginia Tech.

The panel also selected a preseason All-ACC squad which included Monica Wright (Virginia), Carolyn Swords (Boston College), **Jasmine Thomas** (Duke), Jacinta Monroe (Florida State) and Jessica Breland (North Carolina). Wright was also selected Preseason ACC Player of the Year, while North Carolina newcomer Tierra Ruffin-Pratt earned Preseason ACC Freshman of the Year.

Thomas, who is a product of Fairfax, Va., came on strong for the Blue Devils as a junior averaging 10.2 points, 3.3 assists, 2.7 rebounds and 1.7 steals, while starting 28 of 30 games played. Over the final 16 contests of the season, Thomas stepped up her game even more towards the end of the season as she averaged 12.1 points, 3.4 assists, 2.8 rebounds and 1.8 steals the final 16 games of the year. Thomas collected double-figure scoring in 10 out of the final 16 games.

Some of her top contests were against Duke's toughest opponents as she notched 19 points at 13th-ranked Tennessee, 22 points at 15th-ranked Virginia, 19 points versus ninth-ranked North Carolina, 16 points against fourth-ranked Maryland and 16 points versus 18th-ranked Florida State.
