- The Blue Devil bullpen was solid against Fordham, giving up just one run in a combined 10.0 innings.
- Gabriel Saade hit .600 in the three-game set against Fordham and tagged Duke's first homer of the year at the DBAP. He also stole two bases.
- This weekend's series begins a 10-day stretch in which Duke will play nine games. Duke's only day off will be Thursday, March 11.

## STORYLINES

### DUKE GOES 3-0 IN DBAP DEBUT

- The Blue Devils swept the Fordham Rams in a three-game series last weekend in their home debut at the Durham Bulls Athletic Park.
- Duke outscored Fordham 24-11 in the three-game set and had eight extra-base hits, including the first DBAP home run from senior OF **Gabriel Saade**.
- This weekend's series against Temple will be Duke's second three-game set at the DBAP this season.
- The Blue Devils will play 18 home games — six total series — at the park this season.

### LOADED IN THE BULLPEN

- Duke's bullpen was key in the three-game sweep over Fordham last weekend, combining for a 0.90 ERA in 10 innings.
- Duke relievers surrendered just one earned run on five hits while striking out 10 and walking just two batters.
- Sophomore RHP **Ben Grisz** made two appearances and totaled 4.0 scoreless innings.
- Junior RHP **Dennis O'Grady** also contributed 3.0 hitless innings in Saturday's win.
- On the season, the Blue Devil bullpen is 2-1 with one save and a 4.05 ERA.

### FOREMAN SHUTS DOWN FORDHAM

- In his second straight weekend start, senior RHP Jonathan Foreman shut down Fordham for 7.0 innings in an 8-3 win.
- Foreman earned the win and improved to 1-0 after surrendering just two hits and two runs in the series finale on Sunday.
- He retired the side in order five times and held the Rams hitless in six of his seven frames.
- As a sophomore, Foreman logged a 2.87 ERA as Duke's Sunday starter.



In his second weekend start, senior Jonathan Foreman gave up just two hits and two runs over 7.0 innings in a win over Fordham.

### ON THE RISE

- Under fifth-year head coach **Sean McNally**, Duke posted back-to-back 30-win seasons in 2008 and 2009 for the first time since the 1992-98 seasons.
- Duke went 35-24 overall in 2009 and 15-15 in the ACC to make the eight-team ACC Tournament for the first time since 2005.
- The 15 ACC wins were the second most in school history, trailing only the 16-8 record posted by a 1994 Duke team that included current head coach **Sean McNally**.
- McNally is the fastest coach in Duke history to reach 100 wins and boasts a career record of 117-110-1.
- Duke had not won 30 games in seven years prior to McNally's arrival, but has done so in each of the last two seasons.

### MCCURDY MAKES DEBUT AT CATCHER

- Duke senior **Ryan McCurdy**, who was converted from a 3B to catcher during the fall, made his debut behind the plate last weekend against Fordham.
- McCurdy caught all 27 innings in a three-game sweep and let just one wild pitch and one passed ball get by him.
- He also threw out one of two runners who tried to steal against him.
- McCurdy batted .333 (3-for-9) and also logged a .571 OBP in the three games.

### DUKE FRESHMEN MAKING IMPACT

- Duke has used four different freshman in the starting lineup, including 3B **Eric Brady** and 2B/RHP **Marcus Stroman**, who have both started all seven games.
- Brady is tied for the team lead with a .346 batting average and nine hits, while Stroman is hitting .280 with two doubles, a triple and two stolen bases.
- Stroman is also 1-0 with one save and a 2.25 ERA on the mound.
- Freshman OF **Mike Carroll** has also earned five starts as the DH and is hitting .333, while classmate **Devin Burke** was Duke's fourth starter on opening weekend.
- Freshman RHP **Chase Bebout** also tossed two innings out of the bullpen in his debut.

### GOULD STANDARD

- Duke senior **Jeremy Gould** has emerged as one of the best pure hitters in the ACC.
- Gould, a 6-4, 220 pound first baseman, has a career .337 batting average, 11 homers and 40 doubles in his four-year career.
- Gould has hit at least .340 in each of the last three seasons, including a .346 batting average this season.
- Gould has reached base safely in 33 consecutive games, dating back to 2009.

# 2010 DUKE BASEBALL

## STORYLINES

### DUKE = DEFENSE

- Duke ranked among the top five teams in the nation in defensive fielding percentage for the second straight year in 2009, posting a school-record .979 clip.
- That clip broke the previous school record of .978 that Duke compiled in 2008 when the Blue Devils led the nation in the category.
- Duke was the only team in the ACC to finish the year with more double plays (54) than errors committed (47).
- Duke boasts a .971 fielding percentage this season and has turned six double plays in seven games. Duke has eight errors.

### MOVING ON

- Duke had a school-record seven players drafted in 2009, including four seniors and three juniors.
- Duke will have to replace several key pieces of the 2009 team, including first baseman **Nate Freiman**, catcher **Matt Williams**, staff ace **Andrew Wolcott** and outfielder/closer **Alex Hassan**, all of whom were drafted.
- With the loss of the five seniors and Hassan, Duke lost 31 home runs, 177 RBI, 12 wins and eight saves from a year ago.

### STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

- The Blue Devils' 2010 schedule includes seven top-25 opponents, according to the *Baseball America* or Collegiate Baseball Insider polls.
- Six of those teams are ranked in the top 15.
- Nine opponents on Duke's schedule were NCAA Regional Teams.
- Four advanced to a Super Regional.
- Two — North Carolina and Virginia — played in the College World Series.

### GOULD, NESS TABBED PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

- Duke seniors **Jeremy Gould** (1B) and **Michael Ness** (RP) were each named to the Preseason All-ACC Second Team by SEBaseball.com.
- Gould was one of two first basemen in the second team, while Ness earned a spot as a closer on the second team.
- Gould hit .340 as a junior with seven home runs and 37 RBI. He also hit .341 in conference play. He is batting .346 through the first seven games of 2010.
- Ness logged a career-low 2.44 ERA as a junior while going 2-2 with three saves. He is now a member of the starting rotation and will make his second straight Friday start this weekend.

### DUKE KNOCKS OFF NO. 22 GEORGIA

- Duke wasted little time in claiming its first win over a top-25 opponent, taking down No. 22 Georgia 9-5 on Feb. 20.
- Duke, which was 8-10 against top-25 teams in 2009 with series wins over No. 1 North Carolina and No. 7 Georgia Tech, is now 1-1 on the year against top-25 teams.
- The Blue Devils have at least two top-25 wins every year since 2007, including four in 2008 and eight in 2009.

### CLOSING DUTIES UP FOR GRABS

- With the loss of all-time saves record holder Alex Hassan to the MLB Draft, Duke's closing duties are up for grabs.
- Candidates for the job include senior southpaw **Jeremy Gould**, sophomore right-hander **Ben Grisz** and freshman right-hander **Marcus Stroman**.
- Stroman notched Duke's first save of the year with a three-inning appearance against No. 22 Georgia and followed by notching a ninth-inning win against Fordham.

### LEADERSHIP ON PITCHING STAFF

- Duke has five seniors and one redshirt-junior on the pitching staff this season, which is the most in school history.
- That group includes weekend starters **Christopher Manno** and **Michael Ness** and key arms **Will Currier**, **Jonathan Foreman** and **Jeremy Gould**.
- **Michael Seander**, a former Freshman All-America, is also a member of that class. He took a medical redshirt in 2009.
- Those five have combined to throw 620.1 innings during their time at Duke and are a combined 39-27.

### CAPE COD LEAGUE

- Duke baseball has sent several players to the prestigious Cape Cod Baseball League over the past three seasons and will send four for the 2010 summer season.
- In 2009, Duke had five players listed on Cape Cod League rosters after sending five the previous season.
- In 2009, **Jeremy Gould**, **Alex Hassan**, **Michael Ness**, **Eric Pfisterer** and **Jake Lerner** all played in the CCBL.

### FUNDAMENTALLY SOUND

- Duke has ranked among the top five in the nation in fielding percentage in each of the last two seasons.
- Duke led the country with a .978 clip in 2008 and followed with a school-record .979 clip in 2009.
- Duke committed just 47 errors in 59 games last season for the fewest faults in the ACC.
- The Blue Devils boast a .971 fielding percentage this season with six double plays.

### TURNING TWO

- The Blue Devils turned 54 double plays in 2009, which was one shy of tying the school record of 55 set in 2000.
- Duke has already turned six double plays in the first seven games of 2010.
- Duke had at least one turn in 37 of 59 games in 2009 and at least one turn in four games this year.
- Duke freshman second baseman **Marcus Stroman** has turned a team-leading four double plays in his first seven games.

### STREAKING

- Sophomore **Will Piwnica-Worms** emerged as one of the best defensive outfielders in the ACC as a freshman and made just one error while starting all 59 games in center field.
- Piwnica-Worms is currently on a 64-game errorless streak, dating back to the third game of his freshman career.
- As a freshman, Piwnica-Worms was one of just five starting outfielders in the ACC to start at least 50 games and make just one error.

### O'GRADY & SAADE DO IT ALL

- Duke senior **Gabriel Saade** has started at six different positions during his career, while junior **Dennis O'Grady** has started at five different spots.
- Saade has started at SS, 2B, C, LF and RF in his career and also as the designated hitter.
- O'Grady has started games at 2B, 3B, LF, DH and P and also got in at 1B on opening weekend.
- Saade made his first three career starts at catcher during opening weekend and then moved between left field and right field last weekend.
- O'Grady made his first three career starts in left field on Feb. 20-21.
- O'Grady appeared in three different spots in the 10-5 loss to No. 22 Georgia, starting in LF before pitching one inning and playing 1B in the final frame.
- O'Grady has also spent time at 2B this season.

### ROUTINE PLAYS

- Sophomore **Will Piwnica-Worms** has started every game in CF since his freshman year and is currently on a 64-game errorless streak.
- Piwnica-Worms made an error in his second career game, but has since rattled off a streak of 137 consecutive chances without an error.

### MCCURDY BEHIND THE PLATE

- Duke senior **Ryan McCurdy** made the switch from third base to catcher this year and started his first three games at the position against Fordham.
- McCurdy let just one wild pitch and one passed ball get by him during his 27 innings behind the plate against Fordham.
- He also caught one of two runners stealing against him as Fordham only tested him twice on the base paths.
- McCurdy was one of the best defensive infielders in the nation as a sophomore and junior, leading ACC third basemen in fielding percentage for two consecutive seasons.
- McCurdy has still not committed an error behind the plate this season.

### IRON MAN

- Duke SS **Jake Lemmerman** was among the best defensive infielders in the ACC last year, having made just 10 errors in 261 opportunities at his position.
- Lemmerman posted the second best fielding percentage among ACC shortstops behind only 5th round selection Ryan Jackson of Miami.
- In a preseason coaches poll by College Baseball Insider, Lemmerman was named the best defensive infielder in the ACC.

## PITCHING NOTES

### DUKE RETURNS 2/3 OF ROTATION

- Duke returns starting pitchers **Christopher Manno** and **Eric Pfisterer** to make up two of the three members of the weekend rotation.
- Manno, a 6-1 senior left-hander, has led Duke in strikeouts for two seasons and is a former Cape Cod League All-Star.
- Pfisterer, a 6-2 sophomore left-hander, went 3-2 with a 5.00 ERA as a freshman.
- Senior RHPs **Michael Ness** and **Jonathan Foreman** emerged as two other starting options and will make their third straight weekend starts against Temple.

### NESS TO STICK IN ROTATION

- Senior RHP **Michael Ness** made his first start since 2007 on Feb. 20 against Baylor.
- After retiring the first 14 batters he faced and allowing just one run in 5.0 innings, Ness has stuck in the starting rotation.
- Ness has been Duke's top reliever since his freshman year and has logged 69 career appearances. Three of those are starts.
- Ness has a 3.60 ERA after his last start, which was his first since March 17, 2007 when he was a freshman.
- Ness logged a 2.44 ERA as a junior, which was the second lowest among ACC relievers with at least 40.0 innings pitched.

### CALLING THE BULLPEN

- Duke's bullpen has been one of the best in the ACC under pitching coach **Sean Snedeker** and one of the key components in the program's recent success.
- In a three-game sweep against Fordham, Duke's bullpen surrendered just one run in 10.0 innings and held the Rams to a .135 batting average.
- In 2009, the group saved a school-record 17 games while winning 13. Duke went 33-3 when leading after the sixth inning.
- Alex Hassan, who now plays in the Boston Red Sox organization, tied Duke's all-time saves record with eight saves as a junior in 2009.
- In 2008, Duke's bullpen went 17-2 with 12 saves and a 3.00 ERA.

### STROMAN SHINES IN DEBUT

- Duke freshman **Marcus Stroman** made the most of his pitching debut on Feb. 20, throwing three innings out of the bullpen to lock up a 9-5 win over No. 22 Georgia.
- Stroman entered the game with Duke leading 5-4 and held Georgia to one unearned run.
- Stroman has five strikeouts in 4.0 innings along with a 2.25 ERA.
- Stroman was the 2009 Gatorade POTY and Louisville Slugger POTY for New York after going 9-1 with a 0.25 ERA and 120 strikeouts.
- Stroman has also started all seven games at second base for Duke and is batting .280 with two doubles, a triple and a pair of stolen bases.

### SENIOR LEADERSHIP ON THE MOUND

- Duke has five seniors and one redshirt-junior on the pitching staff this season, which is the most fourth-year pitchers that the program has ever had in one season.
- Those six have combined to throw 620.1 innings and are a combined 39-27. They also have a combined ERA of 4.18.
- The group includes **Will Currier**, **Jonathan Foreman**, **Jeremy Gould**, **Christopher Manno**, **Michael Ness** and **Michael Seander**.
- Ness, Manno and Foreman are three of Duke's top four starters, while Currier, Gould and Seander are key arms coming out of the bullpen.
- Seander was a Freshman All-America in 2007, but has missed most of 2008 and 2009 following elbow surgery.

- Duke's pitching staff has prospered under fourth-year pitching **Sean Snedeker**.
- In 2008, Duke ranked sixth in the nation with a 3.71 ERA and 15th in the country with an average of 2.94 walks per nine innings.
- Snedeker's 2009 staff set a school record with 17 saves while ranking 28th nationally with an average of 9.2 hits allowed per game.
- Duke has placed at least one pitcher on the All-ACC team every year under Snedeker.

### TWO-WAY PLAYERS

- Duke is getting the most out of its roster of 27 players, with seven of those players pulling double-duty as position players and pitchers.

- Duke currently ranks seventh in the ACC in fewest strikeouts. The Blue Devils have whiffed 44 times in seven games for an average of 6.3 punchouts per game.
- In 2009, Duke whiffed just 304 times for an average of 5.15 punchouts per game, which was the fewest in the ACC.
- In 2008, Duke struck out just 299 times for an average of 5.34 strikeouts per game, again the fewest in the ACC.
- Duke had three players ranked among the top five toughest batters to strike out in the ACC in 2009, including senior **Ryan McCurdy**, who was the best in the league.
- McCurdy has struck out just 35 times in 617 career plate appearances. That is an average of one strikeout per 17.6 at bats.

## Head Coach **Sean McNally** Fifth Year • Duke, '94

Sean McNally, a 1994 graduate of Duke University,

returns for his fifth year as head baseball coach. With a philosophy based on striving for excellence in the classroom, involvement in the community and achievement on the field, McNally has led the program to great success during his tenure.

With a 120-110-1 record in his first four years, McNally is off to the best start by any coach in Duke history. In 2009, McNally became the first coach to reach 100 wins by his fourth year and the first to compile two 30-win seasons during that span. McNally has also led Duke to more ACC wins in each of his first four seasons, capped by a 15-15 ACC record in 2009.

McNally coaches the hitters and the infielders directly, the same responsibilities he handled at the professional level during his time in player development with the Cleveland Indians. Under McNally, Duke has hit at least .299 in each of the last three seasons while ranking among the top four in the country in fielding percentage for two straight seasons.

The 2009 season featured Duke's second straight 30-win campaign, as the Blue Devils went 35-24 while racking up the second most ACC victories in school history. Duke took two series from top-10 opponents, taking down No. 1 North Carolina and No. 7 Georgia Tech before making a run in the ACC Tournament that included a win over No. 13 Clemson.

Additionally, the Blue Devils posted a 3.233 team GPA and placed an ACC-record nine members of the All-ACC Academic Baseball Team.

Duke saw a school-record seven players drafted under McNally in 2009, including four seniors and three juniors. In McNally's four years, 10 players have now been drafted including two-time draftee **Nate Freiman**, who left the board in the 8th round as a senior.

McNally has put Duke baseball on the map in the professional ranks after producing 11 draft picks in the last three years. A school-record seven Blue Devils were selected in 2009, extending a streak of three

consecutive seasons with at least one player drafted. Duke also had three recruits drafted in 2009 and two in 2008.

McNally has made significant strides on the recruiting trail, bringing in a 2010 freshman class that included three draft picks and a 2009 class that included two draftees. McNally's 2009 group was ranked as the 25th-best class in the nation by *Baseball America*. The jump in recruiting has been one of the most significant factors in the turnaround in Duke baseball, as Duke now boasts a roster that is filled with some of the ACC's top programs.

The consistent emphasis placed on academic achievement under McNally continues to be evident. After dominating the All-ACC Academic Baseball Team with nine selections and the ACC Baseball Scholar-Athlete of the Year in Freiman, Duke has put more members on the ACC academic squad under McNally than any other program. A former Third Team Academic All-America himself, McNally has also seen a combined 60 representatives make the ACC Academic Honor Roll over the past four seasons.

Each year, the Duke Baseball program has taken a more active role in the Durham community as well, culminating in ACC Top Six for Service awards in 2008 and 2009. Some projects completed included time spent at the Miracle League of the Triangle, the Duke-sponsored Verizon "Read with the Blue Devils" and a free baseball clinic at Watts Elementary School.

During his playing career at Duke, McNally was a four-year starter and served as team captain for his final two seasons. An All-ACC choice in 1994, he set single-season school records for batting average (.408) and slugging percentage (.775). He ranks among the top five in school history with 17 triples

McNally is married to the former Kim Voyticky, an All-ACC track performer at Duke. The couple has two children, a three-year-old daughter named Michaela and a one-year-old son named Jackson.
