Alex Beguinet
Head Coach
34th Season

Head coach Alex Beguinet will enter his 34th season at the helm of the Duke program in 2019. Beguinet has compiled a 672-526 (.603) overall record in his 34 years with the Blue Devils and has coached two NCAA Champions.

In Beguinet's time at Duke, the women's program has compiled a 316-292 record under his direction and produced one three-time NCAA Champion and seven All-Americans, while the men's program has posted a 356-234 mark with 18 All-Americans and one NCAA Champion. Beguinet has helped Blue Devil fencers reach the NCAA Fencing Championships in 33 of his 34 years while sending over 100 participants to the national championships.

In 2018, the Duke fencing program sent seven student-athletes to the NCAA Fencing Championships. The Blue Devils were led by senior Pascual Di Tella and sophomore Eoin Gronningsater who captured All-America accolades in saber and foil, respectively. Di Tella concluded a stellar career in 10th while Gronningsater qualified for the second-consecutive year and placed fifth. As a team, the Blue Devils placed 10th, marking their ninth top-10 finish in the past 10 seasons. The 2018 campaign also saw the return of the ACC Fencing Championships on the campus of the University of North Carolina where the men made history by capturing the first ACC team title in program history. The Blue Devil men cruised to a 19-8 victory over the second-ranked team in the country, Notre Dame, and also defeated North Carolina (19-8) and Boston College (24-3) in route to the crown. Duke used an 8-1 advantage in epee and a 7-2 record in foil to hand defending national champion Notre Dame its first fencing loss in an ACC Championship since joining the conference in the 2014-15 season. In individual competition, Di Tella (silver), Gronningsater (silver) and junior epeeist Bryn Hammarberg (gold) all secured medals in their respective weapons. The men ended the regular season with a 23-4 overall record while the women finished 20-8.

Beguinet mentored one of the most successful fencers in NCAA history in three-time NCAA Saber Champion Becca Ward. Ward, who won the bronze medal at the 2008 Olympic Games in Beijing, reached the NCAA Championship match in each of her four seasons. She won the 2009, 2011 and 2012 NCAA titles while finishing as runner-up in 2010. Beguinet also mentored 2007 Duke graduate Ibtihaj Muhammad. Muhammad, who won bronze in women's team saber at the 2016 Olympic Games in Rio, was a three-time All-American and finished her college career ranked 15th nationally among senior women's saber.

Beguinet served at US Fencing's annual summer Junior Olympic Training Camps as a staff member for 10 years, served as coach for several International Cadet Championships and World Championships, and also participated as a coach at the fencing events for seven Olympic Festivals.

Alex Beguinet was the Director of the US Fencing Association's coaching education program, Coaches College, from 1993 until the program was dissolved in 2011, and was a member of the education staff since the program, held annually at US Olympic Training Centers, was first implemented in 1985.

Born in Toulouse, France, Maitre Beguinet received his Master of Arms Degree from the National Sports Institute in Paris in 1976. Beguinet came to Duke after serving eight years as the head fencing coach at Lewis & Clark College in Portland, Ore.

Beguinet was the owner/director of Salle La Boessiere in Portland from 1980-84. While there, in addition to coaching for Lewis and Clark College in Portland, he coached at Portland Community College, Clark College in Vancouver, Wash., Mt. Hood Community College in Gresham, Ore., and instructed for the city of Portland's Park Bureau.

He lives with his wife, Elizabeth, on their recently acquired abandoned farm, restoring it to working order. They have one daughter, Heather, who is a Duke alumnae.

Darius Wei
Assistant Coach
Seventh Season

Darius Wei will enter his seventh year with the program in 2019 after joining the Duke coaching staff in July of 2012. He is a coaching veteran of over 10 years with stints at the University of Rochester (2002-08), the Northwest Fencing Center (2008-2011) and the Vega Fencing Academy (2011-12).

In his sixth season as the staff's foil specialist, Wei helped the Blue Devil men to a 24-3 ledger while the women played to a 23-5 record. Wei mentored a men's foil squad with three fencers with 40+ victories in Eoin Gronningsater (48), Brycen Rushing (48) and Jan Maceczek (45) and two women in Julia Gianneschi (57) and Rhiannon Harvey (40). At the ACC Championships, Gronningsater captured silver while Rushing finished just short of the podium in fourth. At the Mid-Atlantic/South Regional, Rushing placed second while Gronningsater and Harvey notched fifth. Wei also led Gronningsater, Rushing, Harvey and Gianneschi to the NCAA Championships in State College, Pa., as Gronningsater captured fifth place for the first All-America honor of his career.

Previously, Wei coached at the Northwest Fencing Center in Portland, Ore., working with the senior women's foil team that won back-to-back national championships in 2008 and 2009 and the senior men's foil team which won a national championship in 2010 and a bronze medal in 2011. Athletes who have trained with Wei have earned success at a high level, including North American Cup finals, National Championships and NCAA Championship berths.

A native of Greenwood, Ind., Wei holds a B.S. in Computer Science from the Rochester Institute of Technology (2001). He is married to Kathryn Pierrynowski.



Jacek Huchwajda
Assistant Coach
Sixth Season

Former Olympic fencer Jacek Huchwajda will enter his sixth season in 2019 after joining the Duke fencing staff as an assistant coach in July of 2013.

In his fifth year as Duke's saber specialist, Huchwajda helped the men's saber squad to an impressive 23-4 overall record while the women posted a 20-8 ledger. He helped lead seven saberists to compile 30+ wins on the year as Lindsay Sapienza recorded 49 wins. Huchwajda guided Pascual Di Tella to a silver medal at the ACC Championships while Haley Fisher placed fourth, just short of the podium. At the Mid-Atlantic/South Regionals, Di Tella placed second before Di Tella and Agoston Walter headlined the saberists at the NCAA Championships. On the national stage, Di Tella collected his second All-America honor with a 10th-place finish.

Huchwajda, a member of the German National Team who fenced in the 1992 Summer Olympic Games, came to Duke after a seven-year stint as the saber coach at Oregon Fencing Alliance in Portland. At Oregon Fencing Alliance, Huchwajda mentored a number of the nation's top fencers, including former Blue Devil and three-time NCAA Saber Champion Becca Ward.

Prior to his time at Oregon Fencing Alliance, Huchwajda was the saber coach at the world-renowned Tauberbischofsheim Fencing Club in Tauberbischofsheim, Germany, from 1992-2006. During his time at Tauberbischofsheim, Huchwajda coached Olympic bronze medalist Alex Weber, Junior World Cup winner Tamara Biesinger and Cadet World Cup runner-up Mathias Grimm.

Huchwajda enjoyed a decorated fencing career, fencing saber with the German National Team from 1991-98. In addition to twice representing Germany at the Olympics, Huchwajda was a three-time gold medalist at the German Open Saber Championship (1992, 1994, 1996), a two-time team bronze medalist at the World Fencing Championship (1991, 1993), a silver medalist at the 1996 Senior World Cup, a three-time German Senior National individual and team Champion, a three-time German Junior National Champion and a winner of the 1987 Junior World Cup.

Huchwajda also served in the German military in the sport division where he competed as a saber fencer and was the 1991 World Champion at the World Military Championships.

A native of Pozna, Poland, Huchwajda graduated from Trener Academy in 1994. He and his wife, Magda, have four children:

Christophe Duclos will enter his second year with the program in 2019 after joining the Duke coaching staff in August.

In his first year as Duke's epee specialist, Duclos helped the men's epee squad to a 16-11 ledger while the women posted a record of 22-6. Duclos helped guide two fencers to 50 wins in Camille Esnault and Bryn Hammarberg while Maria Papadopoulos (46) and Dean Ischiropoulos (40) rounded out the epee contingent. At the ACC Championships, Hammarberg captured gold for his first individual title while Claudia Wrampelmeier and Amit Sarma each placed fourth. Hammarberg headlined the epeeist's time at the NCAA Championships and finished 20th.

Duclos comes to Durham following his time as a master head coach at the Northwest Fencing Center. Prior to his tenure with the NWFC, Duclos served as a national coach at the Qatar Fencing Federation (2006-11) and at the Jordan Fencing Federation (2005-06).

Throughout the years, Duclos has seen great success as a French fencing master, including leading his junior men's foil team to a bronze medal at the 2007 Asian Fencing Championships in Nantong, China. Duclos helped coach the first Qatari men's foilist to qualify for the 2008 Beijing Olympics and was a two-time Junior Men's Foil Team U.S. National Champion in 2014 and 2015.

Duclos continues his wealth of international experience to Duke as he was a staff member at the 2004 Paralympic Games in Athens, Greece. Duclos also served as the head coach for the Montelimar Fencing Club in France from 2000-03.

A native of Givet, France, Duclos was a member of the Cadet and Junior French National Team and graduated from The National




