Playing their third game in seven days, Duke hits the road to Washington D.C., to take on the 10th-ranked Georgetown Hoyas on March 27 at 12 p.m. at Multi-Sport Field ... The game will be televised live by ESPN with Joe Beninati and Jamie Munro calling the action.

DUKE-GEORGETOWN SERIES HISTORY

Duke and Georgetown are battling it out for the 23rd time overall ... The Blue Devils hold a commanding 16-6 advantage in the series and have won three of the past four outings ... Duke captured a 9-5 win over the Hoyas in Durham in 2009, but lost to Georgetown in Washington D.C., in 2008 ... The last time the Blue Devils beat Georgetown on its home field was on March 24, 2007 with a 6-4 victory ... Duke is 7-3 all-time in Washington D.C.

faceoff duties ... Payton is 41-of-87 (.471) in restarts and Costabile is 42-of-78 (.538) ... In goal, freshman **Dan Wigrizer** has started all eight games and sports a 9.83 goals against average and a .523 save percentage ... Overall the team is allowing 9.45 goals per game, the first time this season the total has been under 10.

SCOUTING GEORGETOWN

Georgetown enters the home contest ranked 10th in the USILA Coaches poll and eighth in the *Inside Lacrosse* rankings ... The Hoyas are 4-2 overall and are coming off of a pair of wins over Providence and Delaware ... Their two losses came at the hands of No. 2 Syracuse and No. 4 Maryland ... Craig Dowd paces the offense with 18 points (6g, 12a), while Travis Comeau has a team-high 13 goals and 14 points overall ... Georgetown has five players with double-digit points on the season and 19 different goal scorers ... Overall the Hoyas are averaging 12.34 goals per game ... Brian Tabb anchors the faceoff game with an 81-of-145 mark (.559) at the X ... Chris Nixon leads the team with 11 caused turnovers ... In goal, C.T. Fisher and Jack Davis are splitting duties ... Both have started three games this season ... Fisher has a 9.71 goals against average and a .507 save percentage, while Davis is allowing 11.61 goals per game and stopping 52.5 percentage of the shots he faces ... The Hoyas are 3-1 at home this season.

IN COMMON

Duke and Georgetown share one current common opponent in Maryland ... Both the Blue Devils and Hoyas lost to the Terrapins ... Georgetown fell 15-13 in its season-opener on Feb. 27, while Duke lost 12-11 at the Face-Off Classic.

DUKE DOMINATES DARTMOUTH

Duke had seven different players tally at least one goal to lead the seventh-ranked Blue Devils to a commanding 15-3 win over Dartmouth ... The starting trio of **Ned Crotty**, **Zach Howell** and **Max Quinzani** on attack combined for 15 points in the victory ... Defensively, Duke held the Big Green scoreless for 34:46 and rattled off nine unanswered in that span.

BREAKOUT GAMES FOR DUKE'S OFFENSE

After scoring just 60 goals in the first six games, Duke has tallied 35 scores in the past two outings ... The Blue Devils registered 20 goals against Penn State and 15 versus Dartmouth ... The starting attack unit of **Ned Crotty**, **Zach Howell** and **Max Quinzani** scored 19 of the goals and 33 of the 61 points.

DUKE IN THE MONTH OF MARCH

Duke has played 303 games in the month of March and sports a 182-121 record all-time in the third month of the year ... The Blue Devils are 23-6 in March under head coach **John Danowski** ... Against the Hoyas, Duke is 12-5 in March.

AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS

Since 2006, Duke has amassed a 45-16 (.738) record versus ranked opponents ... This season the Blue Devils are 2-3 against ranked teams ... In 2009, Duke went 10-3 against teams ranked in the top 20 and 4-3 against teams among the top 10.

TOUGH STRETCH

This weekend's game against Georgetown opens a tough stretch of four games in nine days ... Three of the contests are against teams ranked among the top 20 teams ... After taking on the No. 10 Hoyas, Duke hosts No. 15 Brown on March 30 and travels to No. 16 Harvard on April 2 ... The stretch ends with a contest against Jacksonville in Durham, N.C.

STEVE SCHOEFFEL COMING ON STRONG

Senior midfielder **Steve Schoeffel** started the year with just one goal in the first five games ... Since then the Charlottesville, Va., native has four goals and two assists for six points ... He has five points alone in the past two outings.

McKEE'S CLUTCH GOALS

Senior midfielder **Will McKee** has scored three goals this season with two of them being game-tying tallies to send the Blue Devils into overtime ... The native of Old Greenwich, Conn., registered the tying goal against Bucknell as Duke edged the Bison in overtime ... Against Maryland, McKee came up big again at the right time with a goal with 13 ticks on the clock.

HATS OFF

Senior **Max Quinzani** has scored at least three goals 30 times during his career, including in all eight games this season ... The native of Duxbury, Mass., registered 15 hat tricks over the course of his first two seasons and has 15 total in 2009 and 2010, including all seven games this season ... His first three-goal game came in his freshman season against Air Force.

ROOKIE OFFIT HAS BIG IMPACT OFF THE BENCH

In two games this season, rookie **Josh Offit** has come off the bench to provide a big spark to the Blue Devil offense ... Offit came in late against Penn and scored consecutive goals to launch Duke to the win ... Against North Carolina the first-year attackman sparked a run with two goals as the Blue Devils evened the score at six ... His four goals this season have come in two games.

JONATHAN LIVADAS JOINS DUKE FROM DARTMOUTH

Jonathan Livadas joins the Blue Devil lacrosse team as a graduate student after a strong career for Dartmouth ... With an extra year of eligibility due to injury and a degree from Dartmouth, the native of Wilmington, Del., decided to come to Durham ... Livadas is currently enrolled in Duke's Fuqua Business School.

CROTTY & QUINZANI CLIMB THE CHARTS

Duke's **Ned Crotty** and **Max Quinzani** both are climbing the Duke career charts for overall points as well as assists and goals ... Quinzani currently ranks tied for ninth in career points with 190, while Crotty is 12th with 186 ... Quinzani is third in career goals (162) for the Blue Devils and Crotty is third in career assists at Duke (110).

DUKE IN THE NATIONAL STATS

Duke senior attackman **Ned Crotty** currently leads the nation in assists (3.25/gm), while fellow attacker **Max Quinzani** is fourth in goals (3.88/gm) ... Senior defenseman **Parker McKee** is fifth in caused turnovers (2.25/gm) and sixth in ground balls (6.75/gm) ... As a team, Duke is second in ground balls (38.29/gm) and 10th in caused turnovers (9.86/gm).

FRESHMAN GOALIE EARNS THE NOD

Freshman **Dan Wigrizer** earned the starting nod in his first collegiate game ... The rookie currently leads the ACC with nearly 11 saves per game .. He is the first Duke freshman goalkeeper to earn the starting spot in his first collegiate game in at least the last 20 years ... A native of Villanova, Pa., Wigrizer was named a U.S. Lacrosse High School All-America twice and was tabbed as one of the top incoming goalies in the nation according to *Inside Lacrosse*.

HOME SWEET HOME

Since 2007, Duke is 34-5 at home ... In 2009, Duke went 9-2 at Koskinen Stadium ... The Blue Devils outscored their opponents 137-93 in Durham in 2009.

Seven of Duke's players – **Mike Catalino**, **Tom Clute**, **Ned Crotty**, **Sam Payton**, **Steve Schoeffel**, **Devon Sherwood** and **Dan Theodoridis** – return in 2009 for a fifth season granted by the NCAA in regards to the cancelled 2006 season.

QUINZANI EARNS SENIOR CLASS NOMINATION
