DUKE LANDS 5 ON ALL-ACC

► For the second consecutive season, Duke placed five Blue Devils on the All-ACC squad. The five match a program record. Justin Guterding nabs the honor for the third time, while Danny Fowler and Cade Van Raaphorst repeat. Brad Smith and Joe Stein are first-time recipients. Fowler is the first Duke goaltender to garner All-ACC twice in his career.

LOOKING AT DUKE

► Duke jumped to No. 1 in the polls with the combination of its win over Marquette and Maryland and Albany losing over the weekend. Duke was last ranked No. 1 in the Feb. 18 poll.

► Senior attackman Justin Guterding continues to shine on offense and headlines one of the nation's top offenses with 49 goals and 36 assists for 85 points. Rookie Joe Robertson complements him on attack with 41 points. In the midfield, junior Brad Smith has a career-best 46 points and graduate student Peter Conley has chipped in 33.

► Defensively, Duke has been outstanding in holding opponents to just 7.79 goals and only 29.8 shots per game. The Blue Devils have held opponents without a goal for 15-plus minutes 17 times this season. Cade Van Raaphorst and JT Giles-Harris anchor the close defense with 16 and 20 caused turnovers, respectively. In goal, Danny Fowler sports a 7.88 goals against average and a .554 save percentage.

► Joe Stein and Brian Smyth are sharing duties at the faceoff X. Stein is 92-of-162 (.568), while Smyth is 74-of-164 (.451). They have 37 and 35 ground balls, respectively.

BLUE DEVILS RETURN TO NO. 1

► The Blue Devils, thanks to a commanding 17-5 win over Marquette and losses by Maryland and Albany, vaulted back to the No. 1 spot in the most recent USILA Coaches' Poll. Duke was ranked first for two weeks before falling on the road to Penn.

► This is the latest Duke has been ranked No. 1 since it was atop the polls heading into the 2008 NCAA Tournament. The Blue Devils are 8-5 under head coach John Danowski when ranked No. 1.

LAST TIME WE MET

► Duke held Notre Dame scoreless in the second half and to just two goals overall to post an 8-2 victory on a cold afternoon at Arlotta Stadium. Justin Guterding and Sean Lowrie both had two goals, while Joey Manown had a goal and an assist. Duke was methodical offensively, taking a season-low 23 shots.

► Cade Van Raaphorst shut down Ryder Garnsey, holding Notre Dame's top scorer without a point and to only three shots overall. Duke forced seven turnovers overall and only allowed 10 shots in the second half and none on goal in the third quarter. It was the fewest goals allowed by Duke against an ACC opponent since a 17-2 win over Virginia in 2005. Danny Fowler finished with four saves and five ground balls.

SCOUTING NOTRE DAME

► Notre Dame enters the ACC Tournament as the No. 3 seed with 6-5 overall record after losing to North Carolina.

► Ryder Garnsey leads the offense with 25 points from 16 goals and nine assists. Both Bryan Costabile and Brendan Gleason are back in the lineup after missing some action. Costabile has 23 points (21g, 2a) and Gleason 21. The Irish are scoring just 8.73 goals per game to rank fifth in the ACC and 58th nationally. They have not scored more than nine goals in a game since 13-12 loss to Michigan March 21.

► Defensively, Notre Dame is allowing 8.82 goals per game. In four of the five losses, the Irish have allowed at least 10 goals. John Sexton anchors the defense with 13 caused turnovers and 39 ground balls. In goal, Matt Schmidt sports a 6-4 record with a .473 save percentage and an 8.56 goals against average. He is averaging just 7.09 saves per game.

► John Travisano handles the faceoff duties, winning 112-of-192 draws (.583) and picking up 46 ground balls. He has taken all but 36 faceoffs in 2018.

DUKE - NOTRE DAME IN THE RANKS SINCE 2010

► Notre Dame's No. 16 ranking in the USILA coaches poll this week is the lowest when Duke has faced the Fighting Irish since the NCAA Championship game in 2010 when Notre Dame was 20th. The top 20 matchup will be the 13th between the two teams since 2010. Duke is 5-4 when ranked higher.

FORCING THE ISSUE ON DEFENSE

- Duke's defense has been stifling this season, allowing just 7.79 goals per game to lead the ACC and rank fifth nationally. The Blue Devils are forcing the issue and lead the conference and rank ninth in Division I in caused turnovers per game with an 8.50 average.
- Last season, in which Duke posted one of its best defensive campaigns, the Blue Devils were fourth in the ACC and 46th among Division I teams with only 6.17 caused turnovers per game.

SPECIAL TEAMS REMAIN SPECIAL

- The Blue Devils' man-down defense and man-up offense have been crucial to Duke's success this season. Duke leads the ACC in both categories and is fifth and 10th nationally, respectively.
- The Blue Devils are scoring on 58 percent of their extra-man opportunities and killing off 75 percent of their man-down situations. They are one of eight programs to have percentages above .500 in both.

STEIN EMERGES AS A FORCE AT THE X

▶ Rookie faceoff specialist Joe Stein earned All-ACC honors on the strength of his faceoff play in the latter half of the season. Since stepping up as the go-to guy against Richmond for an injured Brian Smyth, Stein has taken all but 53 of the faceoffs in the eight games in which he has played - he missed the Cleveland State contest due to illness - and sports a .590 success rate.

▶ He has won at least 50 percent of his restarts in five of the eight outings, coming up just short (6-of-14, .429) at Towson and versus Marquette (4-of-9, .444) and getting off to a tough 0-for-3 start at Notre Dame.

▶ Prior to taking the reins against the Spiders, Stein took only 18 faceoffs and won seven (.389). His .590 win percentage in the past eight games would rank first in the league and 19th nationally. Currently, at .568 overall, he leads all rookies nationally, is third in the ACC and ranks 22nd in Division I.

▶ The Blue Devils are developing a special one-two punch at the faceoff X in Brian Smyth and Joe Stein. They have combined to go 166-of-326 (.509) overall and 56 percent (118-of-210) in the past nine games.

▶ Smyth has taken 164 draws, winning 74 (.451), while Stein has taken 162 and won 92 (.568). Smyth has stepped up and come on strong off the bench in Duke's previous three outings, including scoring twice against Virginia and winning 8-of-14 draws.

▶ Against UNC, Smyth won 4-of-5 to help the Blue Devils to the one-goal victory and spell a busy Stein who went 13-of-19 at the X. At Notre Dame, Stein struggled early, but Smyth stepped in and won 5-of-10.

▶ Lacrosse is a family affair for Duke's rookie Joe Robertson as he follows in the footsteps of his three older brothers to play Division I lacrosse. JOHN DANOWSKI

2007-P • 395-192 (35 seasons) • 176-53 at Duke (11 seasons)

Cemented as one of the top coaches in college lacrosse, John Danowski has led the Duke men's lacrosse team to unprecedented success and himself to the top over the Division I men's lacrosse wins list. Danowski was introduced as Duke's eighth head men's lacrosse coach on July 21, 2006 and quickly led the Blue Devils to some of the most successful lacrosse seasons in school history, to three NCAA Championships in five seasons.

In Danowski's 11 years at the helm of the Blue Devils lacrosse program, he has compiled an impressive 176-53 record in leading Duke to seven ACC regular season titles and four ACC tournament titles, eight straight appearances in the national semifinals from 2007-14, four in the NCAA title match and ultimately to the 2010, 2013 and 2014 national titles. The 2014 NCAA crown put Danowski, a winner of 395 career games, among a small group of nine coaches to win three national titles and among eight to capture consecutive crowns. Meanwhile, Duke's run of eight straight NCAA semifinals rank as the second most of any program since 2000 with Syracuse. Most recently, Danowski passed Dom Starsia as the winningest Division I lacrosse history, garnering his 376th win with a 13-6 victory over Jacksonville in 2017.

A winner of nearly 80 percent of his games at Duke, the individual awards Blue Devil players have garnered is equally impressive. In 11 seasons, Danowski mentored 64 All-America selections, 36 All-ACC choices, two Tewaaratron Trophy winners, a pair of USILA Attackman of the Year honorees, a USILA Defenseman of the Year, three USILA Midfielder of the Year award recipients and 21 USILA Scholar All-America picks.

While the success on the field is unsurpassed in Duke lacrosse history, the student-athletes excellence in the classroom also is unrivaled. The Blue Devils consistently lead the ACC in All-ACC Academic picks as well as players on the ACC Academic Honor Roll.
